SECTION B — SHEEP

Chief Steward: Richard Chadwick

No residency limit for entries.

Points will be allocated to class size. Members Entry Fee \$3. Non-Members Entry Fee \$4

Entry Restriction: Exhibitors are limited to two entries in any one Class. Group Classes to be taken from exhibits.

Any exhibit that, in the opinion of the Judges, does not comply with the conditions shall be disqualified. The Judges decision in the matter is final. Shorn classes to be regulation shorn, unless otherwise stated.

All Merino Sheep to be shown in full wool, unless otherwise stated.

Number of days' growth of wool must be shown on entry form and also on tags provided by the Society, which must be attached to the exhibit.

Ages of Sheep: The ages of Sheep must be computed up to the day of judging. Sheep competing in the under 1 ½ year old classes must not show more than two permanent teeth, and Sheep competing in the 1 ½ years and older classes must not show less than four permanent teeth.

Champion Ribbons will be issued to the Champion Ram and Ewe in every Merino and Prime Lamb Breeds Section, also Champion Ewe in Farmers' Classes. Ribbons will also be issued to the Grand Champion Merino Ram (horned or polled) and Grand Champion Merino Ewe & Supreme Exhibit.

Exhibits must be penned not later than 8:30 am on Saturday, and judging will commence at 9:00 am sharp.

Presentation of awards - 2:00pm in ram shed.
