### Royal Agricultural Society of WA Agricultural Art Award

The winning painting in Class 03 (Rural/Agricultural Scene) of the Narrogin and Districts Community Show art section will automatically be entered into the 2012 Royal Agricultural Society of WA Agricultural Art Award, subject to the artist's agreement. Paintings pre-selected and nominated for inclusion in this exhibition will be judged to select the best artwork overall of a rural nature and will be judged solely at the discretion of a panel of judges appointed by the Royal Agricultural Society of WA. This competition offers a first prize of \$1800.
