06. Fibre Art - Does not have to be hangable
07. Indigenous Art - any medium

### Junior Section

#### 7 years & under

Any subject or medium

Examples:- favourite cartoon character, super hero, special pet in any medium—pencils, texta or paint.

#### 8 - 12 Years

Any Subject or medium

Can also include collage.

#### 13 - 17 years

Any subject or medium.
