

## SECTION Y — PHOTOGRAPHY

### Section Rules:

#### Amateur Photography only - No Professional Photography

PHOTOGRAPHY Exhibits (including juniors) must be handed to the Secretary or appropriate Steward before 3pm on Friday the 14<sup>th</sup> October 2011. Entries close on this date.

**Judging** will take place the weekend prior to the show

**Number of Entries:** Maximum of four entries per class is permitted. Photography in all classes must be wholly the work of the entrant. The Author's name or title should not be visible on the front of the print. Prints must not be framed. Prints must be mounted on suitable cardboard with a 3cm black or white border. All care will be taken in handling entries but the Narrogin Agricultural Society (Inc) does not accept responsibility for any loss or damage thereto.

**Digital Imaging/Computer Enhancement:** The original image must be made by the exhibitor on photographic emulsion with a digital imaging camera. Any modification of the original image must be made by the exhibitor or under his/her direction. The final work must be done on photographic film or electronic print material, mounting excepted. Images produced from materials copyrighted by persons other than the maker, are unacceptable.

#### Awards will be presented for:

Most points in Classes 1 – 19 (\$50 voucher)

Runner-up most points in Section 1 – 19 (\$20 voucher)

Most points Classes 20 – 24 (\$50 voucher)

Runner-up most Points classes 20 – 24 (\$20 voucher)

Most outstanding exhibit overall - "John F. Higgins Memorial Photography Award" (\$100)

Mayor's award (\$200) – The Mayor will select one photograph from the exhibits that best depicts an iconic view of Narrogin. Prize conditional on the winner agreeing to allow copies of the winning image to be used in future Town of Narrogin publications.

#### Class

01. Landscape: A picture of natural scenery, which may include trees, people, houses or other objects, provided that these elements do not dominate the picture.
02. Sunrise or Sunset.
03. Tree Study.
04. Waterscape.
05. Water Topic (puddle, rain etc).
06. Rock Study: A picture of rocks in natural state.
07. Sports or Action.
08. Picturesque: A pleasing picture, where composition is important.
09. Animal, Bird or Insect Study: A picture of one or more (or part of one) animals, birds or insects where the subject dominates the picture.
10. Portrait: A study of a person or persons, ranging from head studies to full-length portrait.
11. Child Study: A picture of a child or children engaged in some activity where the emphasis is on the child or children.
12. Child/Adult Study.
13. Child/Children with animals.
14. Group Portrait.
15. People at Work.
16. Farm Activity: depicting any aspect of farm life.
17. Flower Close-up: A close-up of one or more flowers.
18. Humorous - must have caption.
19. Open: A photograph which does not fit classes 1 – 18

20. Group Portrait.
21. Child/Adult Study.
22. Nature: Animals, plants or natural objects in natural environment.
23. Picturesque: A pleasing picture where composition is important.
24. Open: Any photo not previously mentioned in Classes 20-23.
